[MUSIC]

Part One.

Listen and look.

There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

Mch Grandma, here's a photo of my birthday party last Saturday.

F It looks fun! I think all your friends from school were there.

Mch Yes. That's my friend Richard with the striped baseball cap.

F And grey jeans? Oh yes. I know him. I met him last year, didn't I?

Mch Yes, you did.

PAUSE 00'03"

R Can you see the line? This is an example.

Now you listen and draw lines.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE]

Mch Do you see that boy with chopsticks?

F No. Where is he?

Mch Look. The one who's wearing the spotted shorts.

F Oh yes. What's he like? He looks naughty!

Mch You're right Grandma. He really is! His name's David. Our teacher always has to tell him to be quiet.

PAUSE 00'05"

F Who's the girl who's wearing the gold bracelet?

Mch The one who's talking to my Mum?

F No the one who's just fallen over. Look.

Mch Oh yes. That's Holly. She lives near us.

F I hope she was OK.

PAUSE 00'05"

Mch And Betty my best friend gave me a beautiful card. She made it for me.

F Is she the girl with the small card?

Mch No, I mean the girl with the bigger one.

F Oh, so she's the girl who's wearing sunglasses?

Mch Yes, that's her.

PAUSE 00'05"

F Why does that girl look so worried?

Mch Because she's just broken one of my little sister's dolls!

F Oh dear! What's her name?

Mch She's called Katy. Her dad and my dad are good friends.

PAUSE 00'05"

Mch Do you see the boy wearing the blue trainers?

F There are two boys who are wearing those.

Mch Oh, yes. I mean the one who's got a bandage on his knee. He hurt it while he was playing in a football match.

F I see him now.

Mch Well, that's Frank. And he's the laziest student in our class!

PAUSE 00'05"

R *Now listen to Part One again.*

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART ONE WITH ONLY 00'03" PAUSES]

R *That is the end of Part One.*

PAUSE 00'05"

R *Part Two.*

Listen and look.

There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

M OK, boys and girls I'm going to tell you about our trip to the museum on Tuesday.

Fch Which museum are we going to go to?

M The History Museum.

Fch Oh? I don't know that one.

M Well, it's a great place. I've been several times.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Can you see the answer? Now you listen and write.*

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE]

Fch Where is the museum?

M It's on Market Street, very near the High Street. I think it's number 16. It's near the post office.

Fch Shall we take sandwiches and some drinks with us for our lunch?

M You don't have to do that because you'll have a hot lunch at the café there. But I want everyone to take a tablet because you must write down the things that you see.

Fch Oh why do you want us to write things down?

M Well, in the afternoon there will be a short quiz for all the students to do.

Fch Will we have to do something in class on Wednesday after the visit?

M Yes. I want everyone to make something.

Fch Oh, a model?

M Actually no... We're going to make a magazine together.

Fch Oh good! I love doing that!

M I can't go on the museum visit with your class because I'll be on holiday that day. Mrs Johnson is going to go with you.

Fch Oh? I don't know her. How do you spell her name?

M It's J-O-H-N-S-O-N. You'll like her. She's lovely.

PAUSE 00'05"

R Now listen to Part Two again.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART TWO]

R That is the end of Part Two.

PAUSE 00'05"

R *Part Three.*

Listen and look.

There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Sarah's telling Mr Williams about a very long holiday that her grandparents had. Which of these activities did Sarah's grandparents do in each month of their holiday?*

Fch Hello Mr Williams. My grandparents have just come back from a very long holiday.

M Oh? How long did they go away for?

Fch They were away for 6 months!

M Wow! Where did they go?

Fch Lots of places.

M Which place did they like most?

Fch They said they loved visiting some old castles. They spent about two weeks doing that in January because my grandpa's interested in old buildings.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Can you see the letter A? Now you listen and write a letter in each box.*

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE]

Fch In April, they did something different.

M Where did they go then?

Fch Oh sorry. I can't remember the name of the place, but they rode some camels there.

M Oh, I think that's exciting.

Fch Yes it was. Grandma said she didn't like them much.

M Oh dear. Yes, I know they can smell bad sometimes.

PAUSE 00'03"

M Where did your grandparents go in March?

Fch They went to visit my aunt. She lives in the mountains.

M Ah, so did they spend some time walking there?

Fch Actually, they went snowboarding.

M Wow! They sound very healthy!

Fch Yes, they are and they're not very old. They're only 58.

PAUSE 00'03"

M Where did they go in February?

Fch They went to the south of our country.

M Cool! Did they go and see the famous waterfall there?

Fch I don't think they saw that but they visited the jungle and saw lots of interesting animals. The photos are amazing! The colours are fantastic!

M I'm sure they are.

PAUSE 00'03"

Fch In June, they went to stay with my uncle. He's got a big house near a lake and he's got a large boat too.

M Do your grandparents like sailing?

Fch They do, but they didn't do that while they were there.

M So, what did they do then?

Fch They drove racing cars! Grandpa says that Grandma went really fast!

M Your grandma sounds cool!

PAUSE 00'03"

M What about May?

Fch Let me think. Oh yes... they went to a hot country but I'm not sure which one.

M OK. Did they enjoy that?

Fch Yes, they saw some pyramids. My grandpa said he was pleased they did that.

M Well, it sounds like they had a fantastic holiday.

Fch They did. And they bought me lots of unusual presents in all the places they visited, too!

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Now listen to Part Three again.*

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART THREE]

R *That is the end of Part Three.*

PAUSE 00'05"

R *Part Four.*

Listen and look.

There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Which subject did Harry have today?*

PAUSE 00'03"

F Did you have a good day at school, Harry?

Mch It was OK Mom. I want to watch a programme about science later. Is that alright?

F That's fine. Is it for homework?

Mch No my friend told me about it. I have to do geography homework tonight.

F So did you have geography today?

Mch We had it on Monday. We had maths today with a new teacher. He's very nice.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Can you see the tick?*

Now you listen and tick the box.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE]

R *One. What would Harry like to eat now?*

PAUSE 00'03"

F Would you like some bread and olives now, Harry?

Mch I really hate those, Mum.

F No problem. How about some yoghurt then?

Mch That sounds good. I'll put fruit in it.

F OK, there are bananas on top of the cupboard.

Mch Cool.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Two. What is Harry's book about?*

PAUSE 00'03"

F Are you reading your new book about swans?

Mch Oh I gave that one to my friend Emma at school. She's really interested in them.

F I see. So what are you reading about?

Mch Another kind of bird, actually – eagles. They're large birds and very strong.

F I know. Your brother's outside in the garden with a book about beetles. I hope he doesn't bring any into the kitchen.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Three. Where is Harry's dad now?*

PAUSE 00'03"

Mch When will Dad be home? We're going out together later.

F In half an hour, I think.

Mch So, is he at the station, waiting for a train now?

F He drove to work today. He's just called to say he's on the motorway, so I think he will be back before seven o'clock.

Mch Cool. I'll get our bikes ready. We're going to cycle in the park after dinner.

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Four. What does Harry want his mum to buy?*

PAUSE 00'03"

F I'm going to go to the chemist's later but I've forgotten what I need to buy there for you. Did you say you wanted some shampoo?

Mch I've got lots of that. But can you get me a new toothbrush, please?

F Sure. And I have to get a bandage for dad's arm. He hurt himself while he was playing tennis.

Mch Not again!

PAUSE 00'03"

R *Five. Where will Harry go tomorrow?*

PAUSE 00'03"

F It's Saturday tomorrow. You and Grandpa are going to go out, aren't you?

Mch It's going to be a very hot day again so Grandpa said we can go swimming at the new pool.

F Oh, that's a fantastic idea!

Mch And next month there'll be a music festival in town. Grandpa says we can go do that too.

F OK. Oh and don't forget you're going to go to the circus with Jack next Thursday.

M I know. I haven't forgotten.

PAUSE 00'03"

R Now listen to Part Four again.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART FOUR WITH NO PAUSES AFTER THE QUESTIONS]

R That is the end of Part Four.

PAUSE 00'05"

R Part Five.

Listen and look at the picture.

There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

Mch I'd like to colour this picture. Is that OK?

F Yes, that's fine David. Can you see the butterfly?

Mch The one which is flying near the bird?

F Yes, that one. Colour it red.

Mch OK, I'm doing it now.

PAUSE 00'03"

R Can you see the red butterfly? This is an example.

Now you listen and colour and write.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE]

R One

Mch Can I colour the nest in the tree?

F Of course! Do you think brown's a good colour for that?

Mch Oh yes. That's the best colour. I've got it here.

F You're doing a good job!

Mch Brilliant!

PAUSE 00'15"

R Two

Mch I think those aliens are really funny.

F Colour the one that's chatting to the man.

Mch Can I do the one who's coming out of the spaceship?

F Oh, OK. If you want. Make him orange.

Mch Sure!

PAUSE 00'15"

R Three

Mch Do you think the monsters are frightening?

F Yes, I do. Do you want to colour one of them?

Mch Can I write something instead? I can write on the tallest one.

F No, let's write on the shortest one. Write the word THINGS on its backpack. Below the word 'my'. Do you see it?

Mch No problem. I can do that.

PAUSE 00'15"

R Four

F Can you see the dinosaur?

Mch Dinosaurs are extinct now.

F I know they are, but there's a big one in the picture! Can you colour it green?

Mch Well. They're always that colour, aren't they? Can I use pink?

F You're right actually. Yes... use that colour. That'll be better.

PAUSE 00'15"

R Five

Mch OK. What else shall I colour?

F I want you to write something now.

Mch Sure, what would you like me to write?

F Well, can you write something on the spaceship. Next to the word space, write the word TRAVEL.

Mch Cool!

F Your picture looks great now.

PAUSE 00'15"

R Now listen to Part Five again.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART FIVE WITH ONLY 00'10" PAUSES]
